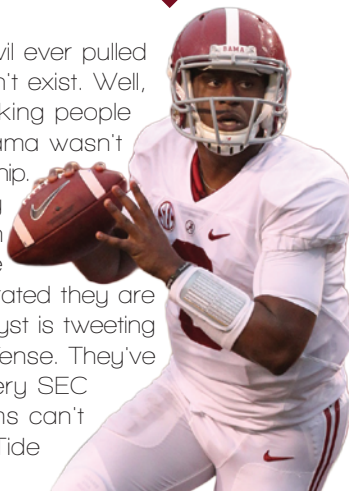

The fact that the SEC West is a combined 26-0 against teams outside of the division has been talked about ad nauseam this week, but could that record receive its first blemish this week? Georgia, the leader in the SEC East, travels to face an Arkansas team that's 0-3 in the conference. That 0-3 record is a bit misleading as the Razorbacks are much-improved from last season and lost to Texas A&M by just 7 points and Alabama by a point. Georgia is still without former Heisman candidate Todd Gurley, and the Razorbacks are only favored by 3.5 points. But if arguably the East's best team, loses to the West's worst, that's not a good look for an Eastern division that has failed to do much of anything impressive halfway through the season.

At least one of the country's six remaining unbeaten teams will go down this weekend, assured by this matchup of 6-0 squads at Doak Campbell Stadium. FSU hasn't lost a game since November 2012, but faces its stiffest test of the season against the Fighting Irish, a team rejuvenated by the return of dual-threat quarterback Everett Golson. Legitimacy is at stake for both sides. The Fighting Irish knocked off Stanford - their only ranked opponent thus far - two weeks ago, but narrowly avoided losing to North Carolina at home last week. And the Seminoles haven't quite been the well-oiled machine they were in 2013. Despite having knocked off two currently-ranked teams in No. 15 Oklahoma State and No. 24 Clemson, FSU dropped to No. 2 in the AP poll this week after Mississippi State's victory over Auburn. The winner of this game will almost certainly be in the driver's seat on the road to the College Football Playoff.

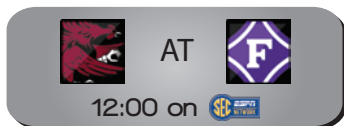

SHAQ ROLAND

Junior Wide Receiver

This is an important week for Roland, a junior wide receiver who missed South Carolina's loss at Kentucky two weeks ago. A former South Carolina Mr. Football Award winner, Roland has NFL aspirations, but hasn't yet had the breakout season many pundits expected of him. He's just quarterback Dylan Thompson's third or fourth favorite target, and his stat line of 15 catches for 180 yards and two touchdowns through five games isn't likely to turn the heads of NFL scouts. In short, Roland needs a comeback performance, something to make his forgettable season and absence at Kentucky a distance memory. Could that come on Saturday against Furman? It's possible; Roland led USC in receiving when the Gamecocks last faced a Football Championship Subdivision opponent, catching four passes for 72 yards and a touchdown in a rout of Coastal Carolina last year.

The SoCon Defensive Player of the Month in September, Wilkins leads the Paladins with nine tackles for loss and 4.5 sacks. The captain also has a pair of forced fumbles on the year and Furman's only defensive touchdown of the season, a 19-yard interception return for the game-winning touchdown against Mercer. Wilkins is currently seventh on Furman's career sack list.



VEGAS REPORT

The lines come out later in the week when FBS programs take on FCS schools. The Westgate SuperBook in Las Vegas opened South Carolina (3-3 straight up, 1-5 against the spread) as a 39-point home favorite vs. Furman on Tuesday. The Vegas betting shop adjusted the number to 38.5 early Wednesday morning.

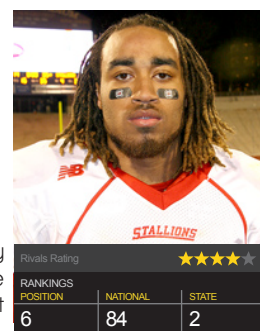

JALAPENO-PIMIENTO CHEESE CAN RUN THE OPTION AT TAILGATING TIME

Saturday's matchup with Furman is the first noon game of the season, and the kickoff time might change up your tailgating menu. While some people stick with burgers, ribs and other night-game classics, others opt to take advantage of the late-morning/midday setting and let bloody Marys, dips and brunch fare take over the table.

This week's recipe – Jalapeno-Pimiento Cheese – is a dual threat because it can be used with either kind of menu you have in mind. You can spread it on crackers, use it as a dip for celery sticks, use it in hot ham biscuits and make sandwiches (full size or finger size) out of it for a lighter menu – but you can also layer it on a burger for a fantastic pimiento cheeseburger or spread it on a hot dog with some chili for a killer chili cheese dog.

The heat from the jalapenos is easy to adjust, depending on your tastes – just like this spread itself can adjust to any tailgating setting you prefer.

JALAPENO-PIMIENTO CHEESE

INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb.(16 ounces) extra-sharp white cheddar cheese
- 1-2 tbsp. minced jalapeno peppers (from a jar is fine)
- 2 (4 oz.) jars diced pimientos, drained
- 1 tsp.sugar
- 1¼ cups mayonnaise
- Salt and pepper to taste



DIRECTIONS

Grate the cheese in a food processor or by hand. Put the cheese in a large mixing bowl, add the rest of the ingredients (just one tablespoon jalapenos to start), and stir to combine well. If desired, add more minced jalapenos until the heat level is where you like it. Makes about 2 cups.

"You have my solemn pledge that no member of this family will think about basketball until at least January, if ever," the statement said.

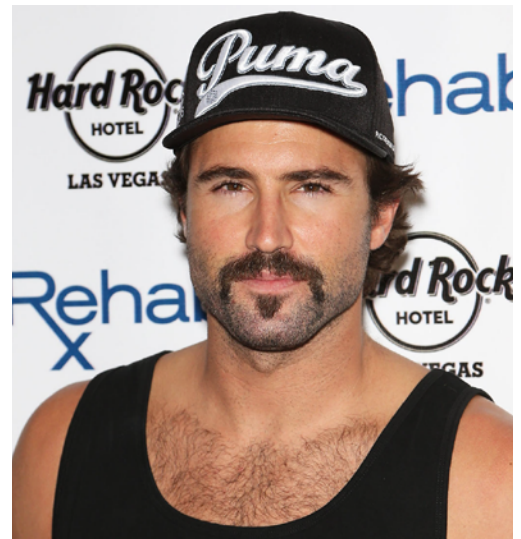
